Project title: New Political Economy Initiative

About the project: The New Political Economy Initiative is a project of IIT Bombay's Centre for Liberal Education. The Initiative aims to rethink the study of the economy by catalyzing a set of research collectives initially around four key economic concerns: jobs, inequality, public goods, and the environment. The Initiative will draw together economists, political scientists, sociologists, historians, geographers, legal scholars, urbanists, technical experts, journalists and research practitioners to build a structural and institutional vision of South Asia's economies, past, present, and future. We will engage scholars from the above disciplines interested in studying the economy in four domains - Jobs, Inequality, Public Goods and Environment. As an initial step, the Initiative will touch upon these domains through four research clusters - Social Structures of the Economy, Industrial Policy & Structural Transformation, Regional Political Economy, and Public Goods & Public Sphere.
